

JEB DUNNUCK**94****2018 Fidelitas Cabernet Sauvignon
Red Mountain**

The appellation 2018 Cabernet Sauvignon Red Mountain comes mostly from the Quintessence Vineyard yet has 27% from the estate Fidelitas vineyard. It spent 22 months in 55% new French oak and there are less than 1,000 cases produced. A gorgeous Red Mountain Cabernet, it offers a medium to full-bodied, ripe, expansive texture as well as classic red and black fruits, chalky minerality, toasted spice, and lead pencil aromas and flavors. The tannins, which can be difficult to manage at Red Mountain, are nicely integrated, the mid-palate is spot on, and this has another 15+ years of prime drinking ahead of it. For a Red Mountain Cabernet, it has solid up-front appeal.
